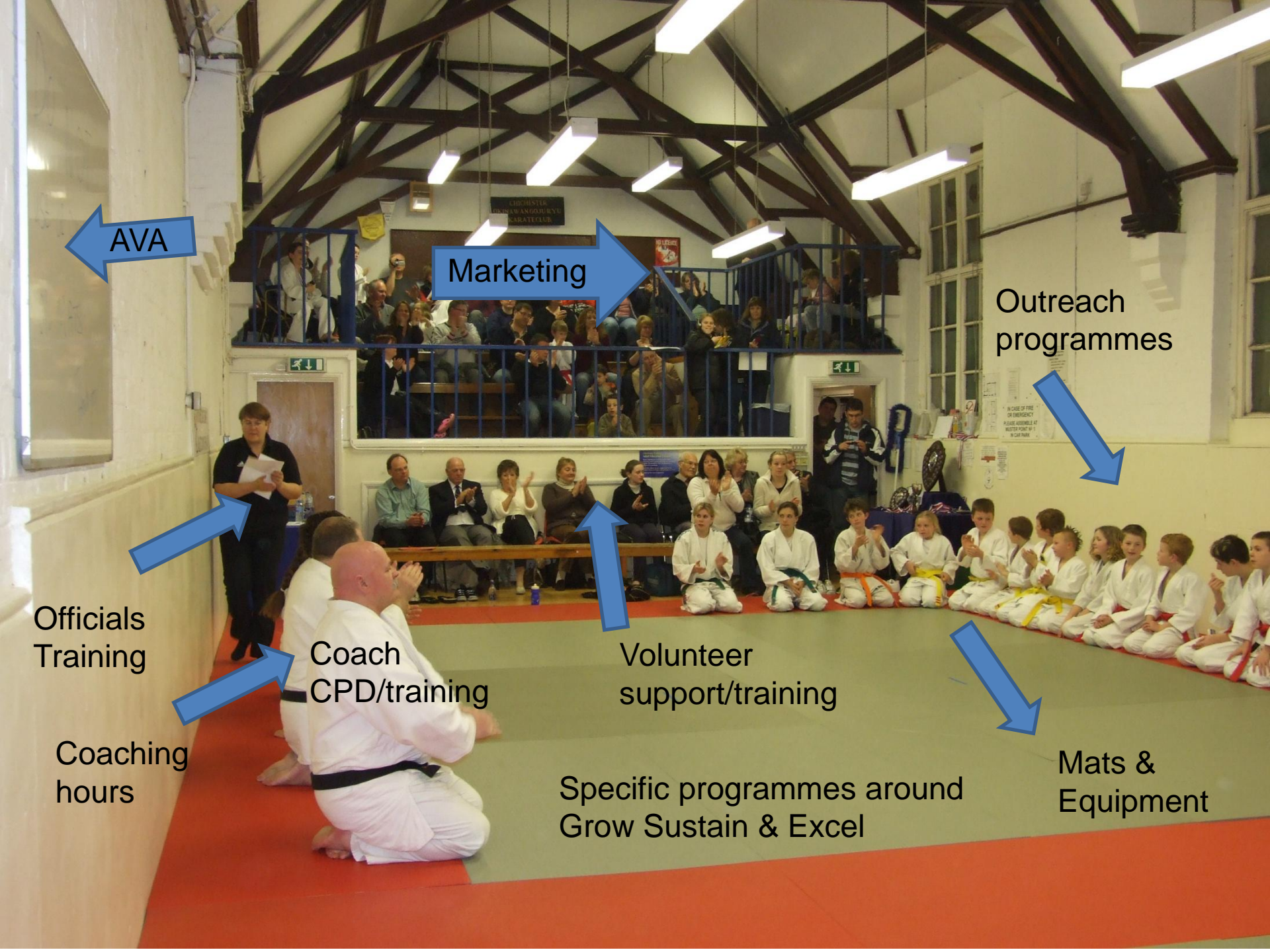

WHO CAN APPLY?

IT IS OPEN TO ANY BONA FIDE NOT-FOR-PROFIT CLUB OR ASSOCIATION, STATUTORY BODY OR EDUCATIONAL ESTABLISHMENT

IT WILL NOT FUND INDIVIDUALS OR ORGANISATIONS ESTABLISHED TO MAKE A PROFIT AND DISTRIBUTE THAT PROFIT TO MEMBERS

SECTION ONE: ABOUT YOUR ORGANISATION

- ARE YOU A REGISTERED CHARITY
- DO YOU HAVE PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE
- DETAILS FROM YOUR ANNUAL ACCOUNTS
- WHAT ARE SAVINGS FOR or
- EXPLAIN DEFICIT
- DETAILS OF YOUR MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

SECTION TWO: YOUR PROJECT

- GIVE YOUR PROJECT A TITLE AND DESCRIBE WHAT YOU WANT TO DO
- WHAT SPORT DO YOU DELIVER
- WHAT REGION WILL YOUR PROJECT TAKE PLACE

SECTION THREE: YOUR PROJECT OUTCOMES AND DELIVERY

- STATE YOUR OUTCOME – GROW, SUSTAIN, EXCEL
- DESCRIBE HOW YOUR PROJECT WILL DELIVER THE OUTCOME
- AND HOW YOU WILL KNOW IF IT IS SUCCESSFUL

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

SECTION FOUR: THIS IS FOR BUILDING PROJECTS AND IS NOT APPLICABLE

- AS A CLUB WITH AN OPEN CONSTITUTION YOUR ANSWER SHOULD BE NO

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

SECTION SIX: THE NEED FOR YOUR PROJECT

- The mats are worn and need replacing
- Enhancing the playing area to increase capacity
- Education support:
 - Increase number of qualified Coaches within the club
 - Support our volunteers – courses / Running Sport / Child Protection
- To retain our developing players in the Sport and support their development need for video equipment to enhance their training and raise standards to the next level
- Marketing / improve links to local schools / Colleges / Universities

Look to put a mixture of areas not just purchase Mats!!!!

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

SECTION SEVEN: YOUR PROJECT BUDGET

- YOU WILL NEED A COMPLETE BREAKDOWN OF THE PROJECT COSTS INCLUDING ANY PARTNERSHIP OR OTHER FUNDING YOU MAY BE RECEIVING
 - YOU MUST HAVE FORMAL QUOTATIONS TO HAND – THESE WILL BE REQUESTED AT A LATER DATE
- ADD IN ANY NON CASH OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS YOU MAY RECEIVE
 - 2 COACHES @ 4 HOURS PER WEEK 50 WEEKS PER ANNUM @ £10 PER HOUR = £4000 PA
 - VOLUNTEERS TO DECORATE BUILDING £400

SECTION EIGHT IS FOR SPONSORING ORGANISATIONS AND IS NOT APPLICABLE

THIS SEEMS QUITE INVOLVED – BUT

- THERE ARE GUIDANCE NOTES TO ASSIST YOU
- YOU CANNOT GO TO ANOTHER SECTION UNTIL THE PRECEDING SECTION IS COMPLETE
- THE FORM WILL HIGHLIGHT ANY ERRORS AND HELP YOU CORRECT THEM
- YOU CAN EXIT THE FORM AT ANY TIME AND GO BACK TO IT AT A LATER DATE

- **Small Grants** has been set up to support local community sport projects which seek to increase participation, sustain participation or develop opportunities for people to excel at their chosen sport. You can apply for awards between £300 - £10,000.
- **Sportsmatch Update:** The programme increases investment in community sport by matching new sponsorship money pound for pound. Having received a large number of high-quality applications for this financial year, we have now committed the Sportsmatch budget. As a result the Investment Centre for Sportsmatch applications will be closed until December
